ADVANCED TRAINING

This training course is for forensic interviewers, child protection workers, tribal social service investigators, law enforcement officers and prosecuting attorneys who have completed the required prerequisites. The course teaches advanced forensic interviewing skills including; modifications to the CornerHouse Forensic Interview Protocol: RATA[®]C for physical abuse and other violent crimes, physical evidence in the forensic interview, autism spectrum disorders, multi-session forensic interviews, a mock cross examination demonstration and active participation in peer review using a variety of written assessment tools.

PREREQUISITES

Completion of one of the following basic interviewing courses:

- CornerHouse Child Sexual Abuse Forensic Interview Training
- On-Site Child Sexual Abuse Forensic Interview Training
- First Witness[™] Forensic Interview Training
- Finding Words[™]/ChildFirst Forensic Interview Training
- Completion of a minimum of (15) interviews using the CornerHouse Forensic Interview Protocol: RATA[®]C (waived for prosecutors).
- Ability to bring a video recorded forensic interview conducted utilizing the CornerHouse Forensic Interview Protocol: RATA[®]C. This will be used for the purpose of confidential peer review (waived for prosecutors).

Advanced Forensic Interview Training

- Four-day training course at CornerHouse
- Small, personal, learning environment; enrollment limited to twelve (12) learners
- Each learner participates in a video-recorded interview practicum, self- and peer-review of a video or audio recorded interview and an individualized skill development session
- Tuition is \$850.00 per learner
- Learners are responsible for the tuition and all costs related to transportation, lodging, and meals

Advanced On-Site Forensic Interview Training

- Three-day training conducted at your site
- Training fee of \$6,500.00 for up to twenty (20) learners
- An agency representative must enter into a contractual agreement for the training and associated expenses including the trainer's travel, lodging, meals and other expenses.
